"Of course we face challenges with the warm climate, high humidity, high level of raw material pollution due to improper storage and heavy dependence on import sources, which are negative to the performance of the pigs. But we are confident of providing the best nutrition solution for our breeds to reach their highest performance.

"We will have a Danish CEO and nutritionist at Vilomix Vietnam to ensure that the Danish feed solution and quality is implemented."
